To support our outreach of community engagement in local schools and with youth diversionary activities with new football equipment to promote football opportunities for young people based in the Strathmartine Ward.

The equipment consists of new footballs, bibs & cones to supplement Dundee West's delivering 30 weekly sessions for over 500 children and young people across the community and ensure more young people are benefiting from the support of the Trust and the Strathmartine CRF with resources they wouldn't have previously had the opportunity to use.

The funding will supply new equipment for sessions targeting young based in SIMD 1 & 2 looking for further opportunities to improve health & well-being during the school day with boys and girls multi-sport/football lunchtime clubs whilst also use some of the funding to purchase new equipment to support Dundee West's youth diversionary projects tackling anti-social behaviour with weekly drop in football sessions across Ardler, Charlotte Street and Kirkton.

These weekly sessions both in school and across the local community hot spots are vital programmes to support young people's week to week timetables and many children benefit with an extra 2 hours of physical activity delivered by Dundee West Community trust. The support of new equipment will allow us to enhance our sessions to ensure we are providing the best quality product to retain young people in our sessions, reduce anti-social behaviour in the community and improve healthier lifestyles for children and young people.

- Increase number of young people taking part in Dundee West's weekly which has put extra demand on more equipment being available for young people and children to use.
- Neither Dundee West CT or local schools have money available to spend on new equipment so the need/support for funding new equipment from the Starthmartine CRF is crucial for the development of our weekly sessions.
- We are targeting young people who don't have these opportunities anywhere else in the community and surrounding area so having Dundee West deliver these free sessions in school and local hot spot areas is important to ensure more young people are getting access that is accessible and inclusive to play and having enough equipment to maintain young people and children in support is crucial to improving an healthier and more equal community.
