Clatto Country Park is a large area to cover logistically and some of our tasks require specialist equipment in order to carry them out.

We need a ladder which can be used to service bird boxes around the park and help with pruning of small trees and bushes. A telescopic ladder best fits our needs and our shortage of storage space.

We need a trolley to transport our tools around the park. This needs to be foldable as we are short of storage space.

We need to replenish our stock of work gloves used by volunteers, third party groups

Two new face shields are also required for pruning or spring back while cutting branches.

We need a 2<sup>nd</sup> First Aid Kit to be based in the Clatto Centre when our portable one is being used elsewhere around the park.

Orange high visibility vests will distinguish the group members from members of the public or third-party volunteers who will be wearing yellow high visibility vests.

All visitors to Clatto Country Park will benefit as will Dundee City Council as work carried out by volunteers around the park is free and can be enjoyed by all.

Friends of Clatto volunteers work to ensure the park is safe for all visitors and ongoing maintenance is necessary to ensure this is the case.

If the bird boxes around the park are not serviced this will discourage birds from nesting and there is also the chance of disease in the boxes. We want to encourage nesting and provide the best chance of chicks to fledge.

The use of a trolley to move items around the park is useful and mitigates some health and safety issues.

Health and safety items are consumables and need to be replaced over time or for good hygiene practices. (gloves etc)

Our needs were discussed amongst Committee members at recent meetings.

Consultation with Dundee Countryside Rangers justify the need for the bird boxes to be serviced after each nesting season as best practice, and the Council does not have the manpower to carry out this yearly task. There have been no objections to us carrying out this task and this benefits the local birdlife in the park. Information is often shared on our Friends of Clatto Facebook page from people that have visited the park and stated that they have noticed improvements that we have carried out that have made their park experience more positive.
