We wish to continue with a rolling project to improve accessibility to the clubhouse facilities for all groups of all ages within the community.

Having already upgraded the Ladies locker room from our own resources we would now like to do the same for the Gents locker room. The current lockers are small and only hold bowls and shoes. The floorspace within the room is limited due to bowling bags containing additional equipment and clothing being stored on the ground. We would like to install larger lockers which would hold bowling bags and ancillary equipment which would negate any trip hazards for all users, in particular those who are partially sighted or have reduced mobility.

The members and visitors would benefit greatly from the unincumbered floorspace and contribute to our ultimate goal to provide full disability access throughout our clubhouse.

The improved facilities would allow us to be more inclusive and attract more members from the local community. This would also improve the sustainability of the club in the longer term.

Our clubhouse is currently used by other groups, for example a mother and toddler group learning BSL. We are encouraging our facilities to be used by any non-bowling groups as part of our commitment to the local community.

The Local Community Plan identifies the need for local facilities to enable people to access support in a local setting. These clubhouse improvements would enable wider use of the premises through improved accessibility and safety.

Access to services is lacking within the area. . This would allow us to be more suitable for local social events throughout the year such as coffee mornings etc.

The improved facilities would allow us to be more inclusive, attract more members and further the usage by other groups from the local community.

The nearest public bowling green at Orchar Park was closed leaving Barnhill as the only bowling club within the vicinity. Our outdoor and indoor facilities would help to improve any participants' health and mental wellbeing, through exercise and social interaction throughout the year.

This would also improve the sustainability of the club in the longer term.
